Can you tell me about The Curtain Club?

- Founded in 1954. 2018-2019 is our 65th season
- The Royal Canadian Air Farce – broadcasted 1st few seasons at 400 Newkirk Road in early 1970's and they are honorary members.
- We last hosted the festival in 2011.
- We produce 5 plays per year (see lobby list)

What is ACT-CO?

- Association of Community Theatres-Central Ontario.
- Created 43 years ago. 40+ member groups.
- Area- Oakville to Bowmanville and Muskoka to Lake Ontario

- WED - Late Company (no intermission)
- THU – This is How We Got Here (no intermission)
- FRI – Outside Mullingar (1 intermission)

How do I get to and park near the RHCPA?

- Travel South on Newkirk Ave continue to Crosby Ave and turn right – continue to Pugsley and turn left - continue to Dunlop and turn right- cross Yonge St onto Wright. On your left.

- Laban movement. Movement to create character.
