- **Burr House - 530 Carrville Road**  
This is an 1820 cottage-style house built by Rowland Burr. Enjoy tea and local arts and crafts for sale.
- **Richmond Hill Heritage Centre - 19 Church Street North**  
A great place to take a take-out lunch you picked up at a local restaurant on our Festival Map.
- **David Dunlap Observatory - 123 Hillview Drive**  
Opened in 1935 it has been a research centre for the University of Toronto's Department of Astronomy and Astrophysics and a facility for public education and outreach.

- **Vishnu Mandir Hindu Temple - 8640 Yonge Street**  
This impressive facility offers The Canadian Museum of Indian Civilization, Wall of Peace, Peace Park, a statue of Mahatma Gandhi and the tallest Hindu statue In North America.

- **Jaffari Community Centre - 9000 Bathurst Street**  
This beautiful centre was built in 1979. For many years, it ranked as the grandest Mosque in the GTA and is a primary centre of worship for members of the Shia Muslim community.

- **L'Arche Daybreak - 11339 Yonge Street**  
Founded in 1969 in Richmond Hill is the oldest L'Arche community in North America, welcoming men and women with intellectual disabilities and the assistants who live, work and learn with them. Crafts are sold at their Craft Studio open daily 9am-12pm and 1pm-4pm.
